This scholarship is awarded annually to Chautauqua County residents planning to attend the U.S. Space Camp in Huntsville, Alabama. Recipients may attend space camp in 2022 or 2023. Applicants may be contacted for an interview with the scholarship decision committee.

Criteria: Applicants must be in at least the 4th grade and have a “B” or better average in math and science with an understanding of the solar system and an interest in space travel, aeronautics and science. Adults may also apply.

A complete application will include the following:

1. This form
2. A typed, one-page essay outlining the following:
 - a. Why you wish to attend Space Camp
 - b. Your interests and hobbies (for students – extracurricular activities)
3. A copy of your most recent report card **(for students in grades 4-12)**

A letter of recommendation from a teacher is recommended but not required
